
## Water for Wimmera Mallee Wetlands Spring 2019



## What do we want to achieve?

Originally 22 wetland sites were selected to receive environmental water in spring 2019; however, site inspections showed many were still full or partially full from the large rainfall event in December 2018 and/or due to winter rainfall.

Sites selected for spring watering have been chosen as they provide critical habitat for native species such as turtles, water birds and frogs, who rely on these wetlands as drinking holes and refuges in a dry landscape.

The Mallee CMA wants to continue working with the community to ensure our Wimmera-Mallee wetlands provide places for people to play, relax, connect with nature, and sustain healthy Country for Aboriginal communities.
